SPECIFICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

NOTE: Specifications may vary from year to year. Recipients should check with the Financial Aid Office for exact specifications of any scholarship they are awarded.

Click here to apply to the following scholarships:

★UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING - LARAMIE

One-time \$1,000 scholarship to be used the first year of attendance. If other scholarships at UW are awarded to this individual, the \$1,000 will be combined with that scholarship, not in addition to unless the other scholarship is less.

★CASPER COLLEGE - CASPER

A tuition scholarship - will pay standard tuition for two semesters. Not renewable. Multiple tuition policy - therefore student can accept only one scholarship designated for tuition.

★CENTRAL WYOMING COLLEGE - RIVERTON

A general academic tuition and general fee scholarship for the fall and spring semester. The student must attend full time. Scholarship is renewable as long as the student completes a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester with a 3.0 GPA.

★EASTERN WYOMING COLLEGE - TORRINGTON

One-year tuition waiver to being in the fall semester immediately following high school graduation; recipient must have a GPA of at least 3.0 to initially receive; 2.5 or higher GPA to renew for second semester.

★LARAMIE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE - CHEYENNE

Tuition scholarship subject to following conditions: The award will be valid for one academic year. Will cover full-time in-state tuition and mandatory fees for two semesters. To receive the first semester award, the student must enroll full time (at least 15 credits) at LCCC during Fall Semester following her graduation from high school. The scholarship is renewable for a second semester if student successfully completes 12 or more credits during the first semester with a minimum semester GPA 2.0 and enrolls full-time for the spring semester.

★NORTHWEST COLLEGE - POWELL

This scholarship for one year will cover the amount of tuition and fees. The recipient will receive one-half of the scholarship each semester.

★SHERIDAN COLLEGE - SHERIDAN

Scholarship to be activated in the Fall Semester following high school graduation. The scholarship covers up to 15 credit hours of in-state tuition plus student and institutional fees, for four consecutive semesters. Student must be enrolled full-time and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. This scholarship may not be used in combination with another tuition/fee scholarship.

★WESTERN WYOMING COMMUNITY COLLEGE - ROCK SPRINGS

Full tuition scholarship to be used for attendance immediately following graduation from high school. Recipient must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and enroll for 12 credits for both the fall and spring term. The scholarship will cover in-state tuition only.

★WYOMING GIRLS STATE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 can be used at any accredited school, be it in Wyoming or out of state, and can include any Vocational Education School or Community College. Financial need and family size will be main considerations in selecting the recipient.

★SAMSUNG AMERICAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be a direct descendant, i.e., child, grandchild, great-grandchild, or a legally adopted child, of a wartime U.S. military veteran who served on active duty. The scholarship may be used for undergraduate study only at an accredited U.S. College or University. The Wyoming Girls State recipient will have their application sent to National for consideration of a scholarship worth up to \$10,000. Every Department Samsung scholar not selected for the larger scholarship will still receive a scholarship in an amount up to \$1,250. **NOTE:** There is a separate application for the Samsung Scholarship available online at <http://www.legion.org/samsung-scholarship-application> that the applicant must complete. Begin working on this immediately as it will require researching for military information and documents. ***You must submit your application online by the June 1st deadline.*** No new applications will be accepted after June 1st
